"COYOTE CREEK" VINEYARD PROFILE...

Coyote Creek Vineyard (Manucci Winery, Inc.) is located on the hills of the old Adelaida canyons, west-side Paso Robles, Central Coast California. Which is "one of the fastest growing vineyard/winery region in the nation". We are a boutique winery, handcrafted, limited production, of Award-winning wines (Zinfandel, Syrah & Merlot). Our wines strongly reflect 100% pure varieties unique to our clay/limestone underlay soil, microclimate, in a 40-acre hillside/terraced vineyard; cared for by Gianni Manucci (Owner/Winemaker), started in 1995 from ground-zero.

TASTING NOTES...



- 1999 Zinfandel (225-cases)
- » 100% pure Zinfandel grapes
- » 14.2% Alcohol by volume

This Zinfandel is cloned from 75-year old California head-pruned vines, it is our second release, it is more mature, which brings forth the primary elements, making this wine so delicious. It was oak barrel fermented (French & American) for over 18-months, and released in April of 2001. Very intense ripe red fruit prevails as the grapes are generally picked at over 25-brix, giving a hint of jamminess to the wine, rich texture & pleasing on the palate. This wine exhibits a wealth of flavors, from thick, soft plum & raspberry flavors to exquisite spicy clove accents. For the Zin-heads, you will remember this one for a long time...

- 1999 Syrah (175-cases)
- » 100% pure Syrah grapes
- » 14.2% Alcohol by volume



This stylish and youthful wine is a winner among the ladies, and most gentlemen too. It was oak barrel fermented (French & American) for over 18-months, and released in April of 2001. Deep in color, with fragrant aromas of classic blueberry, and earth aromas with sweet oak, pepper and spice. Forward fruit and a round mouth contribute to a firm structure and a long finish. This Syrah will continue aging gracefully over the next few years. Trade/Media experts, "you don't know what you are missing..."



- 1999 Merlot (450-cases)
- » 100% pure Merlot grapes
- » 13.5% Alcohol by volume

This Merlot has a subtle but full nose of fruit and oak. It was oak barrel fermented (French & American) for over 18-months, and released in April of 2001. It has a delicate oak balance without masking the wonderful fruit of this popular grape. Very smooth drinking for casual relaxation, with a romantic partner who is easing into the red wine varietal. If you thought Merlot was passé, then you should try this one only to find out why you loved Merlot in the first place..
