Wild Coyote is more than just another wine tasting experience—it is a mystical journey that combines wine, native culture, and art. The spirit of Wild Coyote is felt from the roadside the minute you see the one-of-

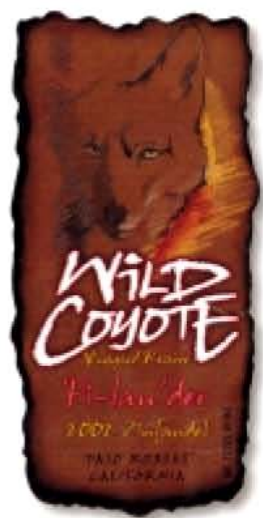
a-kind adobe-style tasting room and a genuine tipi atop the mountain overlooking the vineyard.

Owner and Winemaker Gianni Manucci, raised in California, became an architect,

and then pursued a more creative balance to his life through stone sculpturing. But, his true roots in grape farming began in Europe over three generations ago, which inspired him to return to his ancestry in 1995.

Today, Manucci's hands-on personal skills illuminate the beautiful 40-acre hillside vineyard, and his viticulture education has garnered him numerous winemaking awards. His unique sense of balance has also transformed his vineyard with ancient adobe-style architecture, bed & breakfast (opening in early 2005), an art colony, and winemaking, into a harmonious creation of balance at his winery.

Wild Coyote has a simple philosophy: to be a small estate winery, but be the best at what they do. To the vintners, quality is more important than quantity, and at the winery it's all about the pounds of grapes per vine, not tons per acre. That is why the winery began at the roots, transforming the 40-acre dry orchard farm by pushing through the rocky limestone soils and terracing the hillside similar to their European ancestors. Without question, the winery is a vineyard-driven operation. With a focus on producing the highest quality grapes possible, every wine is made in a traditional with fruit forward style.

'02 Zinfandel "Rejuvenate" Estate Reserve

100% varietal from an old California Zin clone. Barrel aged in French/American oak. Only 175 cases produced. \$29.50

'00 Merlot "Mischievous" Estate Reserve

100% varietal from French clone. Full body, medium dry, fruit forward. Only 550 cases produced. \$19.50
